Hargreaves History

Did You know?

Hargreaves & Son is one of the oldest businesses in Buxton. The shop was trading on Eagle Parade in the 1860's, founded by Mrs Alice Hargreaves. Alice and her son Sam bought out Charles Wilkinson at 14 Spring Gardens in 1896 and traded at both premises for some years. Mrs Hargreaves died in 1904 and her son sold out to local entrepreneur Mr HRP Lomas who chaired the new company registered in the same year. In 1906 Charles Holmes joined from being a department manager at the Quin & Axtens store in Brixton, London. He became a director in 1913 and gradually brought his three sons; Charlie, Percy & Leonard into the business. Percy came managing director and was still chairman until his death, aged 93, in 1996. Charlie managed a hotelware factory in Stoke and Leonard managed two shops in Stockport until his retirement.

The showcases that are a feature in our cafe were brought back from rented premises on Oxford road, Manchester to open the first floor crystal showroom in 1913. The large Wedgwood blue and white jasper vase in the showcase dates back to this time and also the cash tills and memorabilia from the shop through the ages are on display.

The property, built in 1880, was purchased from the Duke of Devonshire estate in 1922 for the princely sum of £4500.

Since Charles Holmes in 1906, four generations of the same family have been serving Buxtonians. Charles up to 1926, Sarah Holmes from 1906 - 1942, Percy Holmes from 1922 - 1996, Ken Holmes from 1949 - 1999, Teresa Coles (nee Holmes) from 1958, Cliff Coles 1970 - 2022, Heather Smith (nee Coles) from 1988 -2020, Martin Coles-Evans from 1989 and Kelly Coles-Evans from 2014.
